

Remote Learning Contract

REMOTE LEARNING is defined as a digital rigorous learning experience completed at home through on-line live or pre-recorded daily lessons, educational programs, assignments, testing, and daily communication with teachers, support staff, and parent/guardian.

The undersigned parent/guardian and students wish to request Remote Learning as our child’s method for receiving instruction for the 2020-21 school year. We acknowledge that we understand and are committed to the following responsibilities that come with this form of learning:

- I understand that learning will be delivered through various on-line tools and software.
- I am responsible for providing a suitable Internet connection in a location where my child can complete his/her learning.
- I understand that I am responsible for monitoring my child’s learning and his/her safe and appropriate use of the Internet.
- The student is responsible for **6 hours of daily participation in learning activities**, which must be logged daily by the student and parent/guardian. Activities may include but are not limited to attending live virtual lessons, viewing pre-recorded lessons, online learning tasks, offline learning tasks.
- I understand that I may be required to make arrangements for my child to take the KS Assessments on-site by appointment in the spring. This will be done in a way to provide the assessment with minimal contact to others.
- The student/family is responsible for daily participation by the student in teacher-initiated contact.
- The parent/guardian is responsible for daily remote learning log completion on the required forms. Forms for the week should be submitted by 6:00 PM on Friday to the classroom teacher.
- Students who are not attending school by participating in daily activities/logs will be considered truant and will be handled in accordance with the district’s attendance policies.
- Students will participate in the same assessments as students who are attending school in-person.
- Student performance on assessments, completion of assigned activities, and time logged on learning activities will be factored into the student’s grade for the subject and/or grade level. Promotion to the next grade level is dependent upon satisfactory completion of this year’s courses.
- I am responsible for maintaining any district-provided equipment and will be financially responsible for any damages to equipment that occurs through negligence, misuse, or loss.
- The USD 461 Board of Education has determined that students and families who choose the At-Home option for school will NOT be involved in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities.
- I understand that I am choosing this learning option for the long-term and that the opportunity to change learning modes will only happen at semester intervals except in extenuating circumstances, wherein the building principal may grant an exception.
